30 DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED ARIZONA STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN REVISION FOR THE WEST PINAL COUNTY PM₁₀ NONATTAINMENT AREA FOR 1987 24-HOUR PARTICULATE MATTER (PM₁₀) NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) opens a thirty day public comment period with the publication of this notice on November 7, 2013, for the proposed Arizona State Implementation Plan (SIP) Revision for the West Pinal County PM₁₀ Nonattainment Area for the 1987 24-hour PM₁₀ National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS).

A public hearing on the proposed SIP revision will be held on Monday, December 9, 2013, at 2:00 p.m., in Conference Room 145 at ADEQ, 1110 W. Washington St., Phoenix, AZ 85007. All interested parties will be given an opportunity at the public hearing to submit comments, data, and views, orally and in writing. Written comments may be submitted prior to or during the public hearing and must be postmarked or received at ADEQ by 5:00 p.m. on December 9, 2013.
