**30 DAY PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD AND PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED ARIZONA STATE IMPLEMENTATION PLAN REVISION FOR THE WEST CENTRAL PINAL COUNTY PM<sub>2.5</sub> NONATTAINMENT AREA FOR 2006 24-HOUR FINE PARTICLES (PM<sub>2.5</sub>) NATIONAL AMBIENT AIR QUALITY STANDARDS**

The Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) opens a thirty-day public comment period with the publication of this notice on February 11, 2014, for the proposed Arizona State Implementation Plan (SIP) Revision for the West Central Pinal County PM<sub>2.5</sub> Nonattainment Area for the 2006 24-hour PM<sub>2.5</sub> National Ambient Air Quality Standards (NAAQS).

A public hearing on the proposed SIP revision will be held on Thursday, March 13, 2014, at 2:00 p.m., in Conference Room 145 at ADEQ, 1110 W. Washington St., Phoenix, AZ 85007. All interested parties will be given an opportunity at the public hearing to submit comments, data, and views, orally and in writing. Written comments may be submitted prior to or during the public hearing and must be postmarked or received at ADEQ by 5:00 p.m. on March 13, 2014.
