



## High Pollution Advisory (HPA) Restrictions



When the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ) issues a High Pollution Advisory (HPA) for:

Particulate Matter, the following apply:

- In [Area A](#)
- **No burning allowed**
  - No wood burning, including wood stoves, fireplaces, outdoor fires, and fire pits or chimneas. All open burning permits are suspended during an HPA. Exemptions are provided to EPA-approved fireplaces and where wood burning provides your “sole source of heat.”<sup>1</sup>
- **OHV (Off Highway Vehicles) use restricted**
  - All off-road vehicles in Area A are prohibited during an HPA unless it is conducted in an area that practices dust abatement measures and the usage of such vehicles are for business purposes.<sup>2</sup>
- County employees or contractors are prohibited from operating leaf blowers<sup>3</sup>

**Area A Seasonal Burn Restriction (May 1 through September 30)**<sup>4</sup> – No outdoor burning allowed in Area A.
