



Kennel Permits are required for all residences that house or maintain five or more dogs. In the following packet you will find all the necessary steps and forms to apply for a Kennel Permit along with a copy of the Pinal County Rabies and Animal Control Ordinance Number 050510 which require Kennel Permits.

We appreciate that you are interested in obtaining a Kennel Permit and want to make this a smooth process for all parties involved. The process, requirements and fees will change effective June 7, 2010, and it would be appreciated if you would read and become familiar with the new developments.

Enclosed you will find the following:

- **Kennel Permit Application.** This is to be filled out and returned to Pinal County Animal Care and Control (PCACC).

The appropriate Kennel Permit fee will be collected after the Kennel Inspection is approved by the Director of Pinal County Animal Care and Control.

- \$150.00 per year for a Class I Non-Commercial Kennel.
- \$150.00 per year for a Class II Non-Commercial Kennel.
- \$150.00 per year for a Class III Commercial Kennel.
- \$450.00 per Year for a Class IV Commercial Kennel.

There will also be a \$25 late fee for any application that is not submitted by the date requested.

In an effort to reduce the number of inspections not passing the first time, every Kennel Permit Application includes a copy of the checklist that will be completed by the Officer at the time of inspection. Please look over this checklist carefully and address each requirement. Any kennel inspection requiring more than one inspection to pass will be assessed and additional \$50.00 reinspection fee for each time the officer must return.

- **Declaration of Intent.** This is to be filled out and returned to PCACC. This is to establish the use of the kennel and must be notarized. Any property that will be used for any type of business even by donation will be considered a commercial income.

- **Kennel Inventory.** This is to be filled out and returned to PCACC. This document must be filled out with all the dogs that are currently housed at the residence. Indoor and outdoor dogs must be listed by name, breed, gender, approximate age and date of rabies vaccination expiration.
- **Pinal County Animal Care and Control Kennel Inspection Check List**
- **Pinal County Animal Control Ordinance No. 050510**

When filing a Kennel Permit Application, the following must be included:

- A sketch of facility and site plan.
- A copy of a current rabies certificate for each dog over the age of three months being housed at the residence.
- All applications for commercial kennels must comply with applicable Pinal County Zoning Ordinance provisions regulating commercial kennels.

**If you have been issued a citation for no Kennel Permit, you must file your completed Kennel Permit Application including all rabies certificates before the plea date on the citation.**
