

2012 Phoenix Metropolitan Area Important Emissions Testing Information

Including portions of Pinal and Yavapai Counties

Most 2008 and newer model year vehicles do not require testing.

Vehicles newer than 1966, but older than 2008, must be tested and must pass the emissions test in order to be registered in the State of Arizona.

Emission testing is required for vehicles registered within designated emission control areas. If your vehicle has not previously required an emission test, is temporarily out of Arizona, is registered outside the area or in a zip code crossing the area boundary ("Code 52"), please visit www.myAZcar.com to determine if testing is required. An "Address Locator" Tool and applications for out-of-state, out-of-area, or military exemptions are available on the website. For help, call: 1-877-692-9227.

Pima County inspections, except for On-Board Diagnostic (OBD) tests, are not valid for registration in Maricopa County.

Getting Ready for Your Test:

Warm up the vehicle's engine before you arrive.

An overheated engine may cause your vehicle to fail. To avoid overheating while waiting, keep the engine running and, while in neutral or park, occasionally rev the engine for 15 seconds at a time. Turn off your air conditioner.

Please do not bring passengers or pets. Most vehicles will be driven by station personnel. You will be required to move to a passenger seat or exit the vehicle.

Trailers need to be removed from vehicles prior to entering the station property.

Vehicles must be able to enter the station under their own power.

1996 and newer OBD tested vehicles will not pass the test if the check engine light is on. It is advisable to have the vehicle tested to determine the reason for the light being illuminated. Repair costs prior to initial failure **will not** be considered when applying for a waiver.

Alternative Fuel Vehicles:

2010 and newer vehicles may be exempt from the emissions testing requirement, a registration "in-lieu of testing" fee does apply. Call 602-771-3954 to determine if your vehicle is exempt.

Exempt vehicles can be either:

1. Be emissions tested, a test fee will be charged. Pay the registration renewal without in-lieu fee payable to Motor Vehicle Division.
Note: An exempt vehicle which is tested and fails cannot be registered until repaired. **Or**
2. Not be emissions tested. Pay the registration renewal fee and the \$12.50 in-lieu fee payable to Motor Vehicle Division.

Emissions Test Fees:

- ◆ **\$27.75** every other year for 1981 and newer model year vehicles with a Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR) of 8,500 pounds or less. **Check your vehicle registration renewal form to determine if your vehicle needs to be tested this year or call 1-877-692-9227.**
- ◆ **\$19** every year for
 - a) 1967 through 1980 model year vehicles
 - b) 1967 and newer model year diesel vehicles with a GVWR of 8,500 pounds or less and motorcycles
 - c) 1981 and newer model year vehicles with a GVWR greater than 8,500 pounds
 - d) 1981 through 1995 model year vehicles with a GVWR of 8,500 pounds or less that are equipped with all-time 4X4 or traction control
- ◆ **\$28** every year for 1967 and newer diesel vehicles with a GVWR greater than 8,500 pounds

Lane 1 is an OBD express lane for faster service. This facility can accommodate heavy duty trucks over 13 feet in height.

Southwest of South 16th St. & East University Dr. (Phoenix)

North Valley

- ◆ **501 W. Deer Valley Rd.**
East of 7th Ave. on West Deer Valley Rd. (Phoenix) Lane 1 is an OBD express lane for faster service.
- ◆ **8448 E. Evans Rd.**
Southwest of East Raintree Dr. & North Northsight Blvd. (Scottsdale) Lanes 3 and 4 are OBD express lanes for faster service.

West Valley

- ◆ **5850 W. Beverly Ln.**
Southeast of West Bell Rd. & North 59th Ave. (Glendale)
Lanes 1 and 4 are OBD express lanes for faster service. Not for vehicles 45 feet and longer.
- ◆ **7140 N. 110th Ave.**
Northwest of North Glen Harbor Blvd. & West Glendale Ave. (Glendale)
Lane 1 is an OBD express lane for faster service. Not for vehicles 45 feet and longer.

- ◆ **10210 N. 23rd Ave.**
Southwest of West Peoria Ave. & North 19th Ave. (Phoenix)
Lane 1 is an OBD express lane for faster service.
- ◆ **5302 W. Roosevelt St.**
West of North 51st Ave. on West Roosevelt St. (Phoenix)
Lane 1 is an OBD express lane for faster service. This facility can accommodate heavy duty trucks over 13 feet in height.
- ◆ **13425 W. Westgate Dr.**
Northwest of West Bell Rd. & North 134th Dr. (Surprise)
Lane 3 is an OBD express lane for faster service.
- ◆ **16140 W. Eddie Albert Way**
Northeast of MC Hwy 85 & South Sarival Ave. (Goodyear)
Lane 1 is an OBD express lane for faster service.

East/Southeast Valley

- ◆ **1851 W. 1st Ave.**
Southeast of West Main St. & South Dobson Rd. (Mesa)
Lanes 1 and 4 are OBD express lanes for faster service. Not for vehicles 45 feet and longer.
- ◆ **4442 E. Ivy St.**
Southeast of East McKellips Rd. & North Greenfield Rd. (Mesa)
Lane 1 is an OBD express lane for faster service. Not for vehicles 45 feet and longer.

- ◆ **20 N. Beck Ave.**
Southeast of West Chandler Blvd. & South 56th St. (Chandler)
Lane 1 is an OBD express lane for faster service.
- ◆ **2360 S. Airport Blvd.**
Southeast of East Germann Rd. & South McQueen Rd. (Chandler)
Lane 3 is an OBD express lane for faster service.
- ◆ **565 E. 38th Ave.**
Northwest of South Winchester Rd. & East Baseline Ave. (Apache Junction) Lane 1 is an OBD express lane for faster service.



Inspection Station Hours:

- ◆ **Monday-Friday:** 8 a.m. - 7 p.m.
- ◆ **Saturday:** 8 a.m. - 5 p.m.
- ◆ **Closed:** New Year's Day, Memorial Day, July 4, Labor Day, Thanksgiving, Christmas Eve and Christmas Day

Payment Method:

Payment may be made by **cash, check, credit or debit card.** (Visa, Mastercard, AMEX)

Checks must have an imprinted name and physical in-state address (not P.O. box), made payable to: **Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ).** A valid driver's license or other official photo identification is required.

No refunds will be given if you take your car to be tested and you were not required to do so. **Check the Emissions Testing Required section of your registration renewal notice to determine if your car needs to be tested this year or call 1-877-692-9227.**

If Your Vehicle Fails the Test:

If your vehicle fails an initial test or a paid re-test, you have the right to a free re-test if you return within 60 days and provide the repair information requested on the back of the vehicle inspection report.

If your vehicle fails two tests, you may be eligible for a repair waiver for a fee of \$15. This repair waiver is valid for the current vehicle registration only. Once a waiver is granted, the vehicle is not eligible for future emissions testing waivers. For more information on waiver requirements, go to www.vei.azdeq.gov/waivers or call 602-771-3954.

Before making necessary repairs, many vehicles have specific warranty provisions for emissions related repairs. Check your owner's manual, emissions control warranty information pamphlet, or your dealer for information on whether your vehicle has warranty coverage.
