How Much Will Testing Cost & How Often Must My Vehicle Be Tested?

Most 2005 & newer model year vehicles do not require an emissions test. Please see the Alternative Fuel Vehicle Special Requirements section. All 2003 and older model year vehicles are required to receive a passing test annually **except OBD (on board diagnostics)**.

| b) All heavy-duty vehicles over 26,000 lbs. GVWR | \$12.25 Annually |

* If your vehicle fails an initial test or paid retest, you have the right to a free retest if you return within 60 days & provide the repair information requested on the back of the vehicle inspection report.

Payment Method

Credit & debit cards are now accepted. Checks must have an imprinted name & physical in-state street address (not P.O. Box), and be made payable to the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality (ADEQ). A valid driver's license, other official photo identification or bank guarantee card is required.

Remember

1. Shortest wait times are generally Monday through Friday from 5 p.m. to 7 p.m. or Saturday afternoon.
2. Thoroughly warm up your engine before you arrive.
3. An overheated engine may cause your vehicle to fail inspection.
To avoid overheating while waiting:
 - ⊕ Keep your engine running, and while in neutral or park, occasionally rev the engine for 15 seconds at a time.
 - ⊕ Turn off your air conditioner
4. Please do not bring passengers or animals. Vehicles will be driven by station personnel and you will be required to either move to a passenger seat or exit the vehicle.
5. Vehicles to be tested **must enter the station** under their own power.
6. Trailers must be removed from vehicles that are to be tested.
7. PIMA COUNTY VEHICLE INSPECTIONS ARE NOT VALID IN MARICOPA COUNTY **except OBD inspections**.
8. **1996 & newer OBD tested vehicles will not pass the test if the vehicle's check engine light is on.**

Alternative Fuel Vehicle Special Requirements

Model year 2007 and newer original equipment alternative fuel vehicles may be exempt. Call (520) 628-5651.

YOU HAVE TWO OPTIONS:

1. **Have Your Vehicle Tested** and complete the registration process. (*Owners of motor vehicles still under federal warranties for emissions systems may prefer to have their vehicle tested in order to get warranty-covered repairs. See your Owner's Manual for details.*) Do not pay the in lieu fee. Any exempt vehicle tested & fails cannot be registered.

2. **Do Not Have Your Vehicle Tested** and complete the registration process; include the required Pima County one-year registration renewal in lieu fee of \$9.00 along with other registration fees, payable to the Motor Vehicle Division (MVD).

Vehicles Registered Outside Of The Emissions Inspection Area

You may verify if your vehicle is registered outside of the emissions test area by using the "VEI Address Locator". Go to www.myAZcar.com and click on the link "Outside Test Area" on the right. Remember, vehicles used to commute to work or school inside the emissions test area must be inspected. For further information, call 1-877-myAZcar.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Pima County Voluntary Vehicle & Retrofit Program

Only those vehicles with a failure in the emissions inspection portion may qualify for financial vehicle repair assistance through the Pima County Department of Environmental Quality. **(Pima residents only)**

Qualification

If you answer yes to all of the following questions, you may qualify for financial assistance through this program:

- ✦ Is your vehicle currently failing the Arizona state emissions test?
- ✦ Is your vehicle 12 years of age or older?
- ✦ Has your vehicle been registered during the last 12 months in Arizona without a break in registration for more than 60 days?
- ✦ Is your vehicle titled in Arizona?

One Time Only Waivers

Vehicles may receive only one repair waiver, at a fee of \$15.00, which is valid for the current vehicle registration. Waiver eligibility requires at least two (2) test failures. Once a waiver has been granted, the vehicle is not eligible for another waiver in future years. Failing vehicles which have already received a waiver must be repaired and pass inspection before renewing registration in metro Phoenix or Tucson. Vehicles which exceed two times the allowable emissions standard are not eligible for a waiver until the vehicle is repaired sufficiently to reduce the emissions to less than twice the standard. Vehicles that fail due to failure of the catalytic converter are not eligible for a waiver. If your vehicle fails, it may be better to repair the vehicle to pass inspection, rather than to seek a waiver. State law requires the seller of a vehicle that has received a waiver to tell any potential buyer that the vehicle is not eligible for a waiver in future years.

Emissions Inspection Verification/Vehicles Out Of State

You may verify if your vehicle is outside of the emissions test area by using the "VEI Address Location". Go to www.myAZcar.com and click on the link "Outside Test Area" on the right. Remember, vehicles used to commute to work or school inside the emissions test area must be inspected. If your vehicle is out of state at test time, visit www.myAZcar.com or call (520) 628-5651.

Extended Warranty Coverage

Many vehicles have specific warranty provisions for emissions related repairs. Consult your Owner's Manual, Emissions Control Warranty Information pamphlet or your dealer for information on whether your vehicle has warranty coverage before making necessary repairs.
