



cloudLibrary & Nook Devices

The Pinal County Library District offers the cloudLibrary to our customers as a resource for eBooks on Nook devices. In order to check out any Cloud Library eBook, you will need a PCLD library card in good standing. You can check out up to three titles simultaneously for up to three weeks each and can place holds on up to three titles at a time.

What you'll need:

- NOOK Color™, NOOK Tablet™, NOOK®HD, or NOOK®HD+
- PCLD library card and PIN
- Wi-Fi access



Download the cloudLibrary App to your device

- Open up the “Shop” section
- Search for “cloudLibrary”
- Install the app



Launch the cloudLibrary App and register your library card

- Select your state
- Select your library
- Enter your library card number and PIN
- Select Login & Start Browsing

Browse and check out an eBook

There are three ways to browse for eBooks:

1. Check out “Featured,” which are custom shelves created by your library
2. Browse by category
3. Search for eBooks by title, author, or keyword

To check out an eBook:

- Check out an eBook by clicking the green “Check Out” button
- If the book is checked-out, you can place a hold on the title, reserving your spot

Read the eBook

- Once you click “Check Out” the eBook will download immediately and open up
- Tap the “Setting” icon at the top to change font size, read in night-time mode, and use the bookmark features to keep your page marked when reading on other devices
