Pinal Comprehensive Plan Project Website Live

The Pinal County Board of Supervisors initiated a comprehensive public outreach effort to communicate and involve residents, landowners, and municipalities in the update of the Comprehensive Plan. The purpose is to determine a plan to manage growth to ensure a livable, sustainable and competitive County that preserves the quality of life. A key tool to communicate about the planning effort and to solicit input during the process is the project website www.PinalCountyPlan.com.

The project website will provide residents with the most up-to-date information regarding the project, including upcoming event dates and latest work product. This site will also be a place for residents to find ways to get involved in the process-including a webpage where residents can submit their comments regarding the project. The website includes:

Over 100 public events are planned as part of the process. The first series of public events that will be held over the next 12-months are scheduled for July 2007. Nine Road Shows will be conducted around Pinal County to discuss future growth and development of the county. People are invited to participate in one or more of the Road Shows. The information presented will be the same at each event, but due to the dynamics of the various locations and participants, the dialogue will vary. The Consulting Team will present Pinal County “Realities and Opportunities” and facilitate a dialogue about resident’s visions and ideas.

The information collected from the Road Shows will assist in developing a framework for the creation of the County’s Vision. In August, another series of Vision Workshops will be organized around the county to develop the Pinal County Vision Statement that will guide the development of the Pinal County Comprehensive Plan. When completed, the plan will be a tool to help guide and shape the county’s future growth.
