



PERMIT SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Anyone requesting authorization to work in the Pinal County Right-of-Way is required to submit the following. These items must be submitted simultaneously with the application for the Utility Right-of-Way permit in order to expedite the permitting process.

1. Two sets of plans for review.
2. A copy of the contractor's license, proof of bonding and insurance.
3. A copy of certificate of insurance, naming Pinal County as the additional insured for a minimum of one million dollars (\$1,000,000.00).
4. A cash bond in the amount of \$1,000.00 (minimum) or a performance bond in the amount of \$5,000.00 (minimum) or the cost of the job, whichever is greater.
5. A County approved Traffic Control Plan utilizing the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Device Standards.
