



US 60 Corridor Improvement Projects



- 1 The first project starting in June (Oak Flat to Miami Highway Improvements) will include building a new westbound climbing lane from Devils Canyon to Oak Flat, widening shoulders in Devil's Canyon, Waterfall Canyon bridge improvements and extending a concrete drainage box just outside of Miami. The climbing lane construction will require blasting which will require intermittent lengthy closures of US 60.
- 2 The second project starting mid-summer (Silver King/Superior Widening) will include continuing the divided highway from where it currently ends at the Boyce Thompson Arboretum and continuing it to Superior, where it will then transition into a five-lane highway through Superior.
- 3 The third project starting late summer (Queen Creek Tunnel Lighting) will include replacing the outdated lighting system in the tunnel with a new modern LED lighting system.
- 4 The last project starting early fall (Queen Creek Rockfall Mitigation) will include removing loose rock adjacent to the Queen Creek Tunnel. This project will require intermittent closures of US 60.

ADOT is working to minimize the traffic impacts these projects will cause on US 60. As each project prepares to start, ADOT will inform the public about planned highway restrictions as they become available.
