Powers

The Transportation Advisory Committee is the recommending body to the Pinal County Board of Supervisors on transportation planning, construction, and maintenance projects within the county's jurisdictional boundaries. The committee annually reviews, updates, and recommends a fiscally constrained, five-year transportation improvement and maintenance program.

Membership

The committee is a ten-member panel, consisting of two members from each of Pinal County's five supervisory districts that is appointed by the Board of Supervisors.
