Records are maintained by the Contractor with access given to Pinal County as needed.
7. How many providers are currently needed?  

We currently have contracts with five different companies with varying numbers of providers. At least one provider would need to be an inpatient provider who can provide priority for court-ordered evaluation patients.

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8. How many hours a week are they needed?

This fluctuates based on the number of probationers and the number of court-ordered evaluations needed.

9. Is this ROQ for perm providers or temporary providers?

We are looking for permanent providers.

10. Regarding program and delivery (2.4.10)...Do we the contractor have to provide the program? Or is it provided by Pinal County?

The program must be provided by the Contractor following the requirements outlined in the ROQ.

11. Are these needs considered Outpatient or Inpatient?

Both, depending on the service being provided.

12. Does the hourly rate presented have to be a firm fixed rate for the 5 year period?

It's not required, but we would prefer that.

13. Do the rates need to be all inclusive? (ie...include travel and lodging)
