## **The Pinal County Senior Resource Center**

The Pinal County Senior Resource Center exists to assist seniors with problems which they may encounter. The Center does not provide services in most cases but the Center volunteers will assist seniors to find the resources they need. In some cases, the senior may need to come to the center.

The center is also in partnership with the Arizona Attorney General's Office as an AZ AG Satellite Office. More information will be found on the back of this brochure.

In addition, the center provides coordination for various senior programs sponsored by the Pinal County TRIAD's. These include the 9-1-1 Cell Phone program, refrigerator medical cards and other TRIAD activities.

## **What is TRIAD?**

TRIAD, a partnership between seniors, law enforcement and the County Attorney's Office, strives to prevent crimes against the elderly and improve their quality of living.

Community education is an important part of TRIAD. They meet once a month with interested seniors to keep them informed and listen to their concerns. Anyone is welcome to attend.

TRIAD offers several programs in each community including the telephone reassurance program.

## **Legal Services**

Legal assistance is provided for seniors by qualified professionals. The Pinal-Gila Council for Senior Citizens offers these services once a month. No fee is required. Call 520-866-6075 or stop by the center for an appointment.

## **The 9-1-1 Cell Phone Program**

The 9-1-1 cell phone program for seniors consists of recycled cell phones to be distributed to seniors upon request. These phones are checked over, cleaned by the center and made ready for distribution.

9-1-1 cell phones are given out at no cost. Local or long distance call cannot be made on these phones. They are the sole purpose of contacting 9-1-1 should the need arise.

## **To obtain a 9-1-1 Cell Phone**

If you live in or near Florence, drop by the office at 94 W. Butte, fill out the paperwork, receive brief instruction and take one home with you.
