Returning home, Friday, July 12, 2013, after a long day volunteering at the Phoenix VA South East Medical Clinic, Rip had a blow-out on our Avalanche truck. It occurred while traveling East on Highway 60 near the Bashas' Shopping Center Complex at approximately 4:30 p.m. About 20 minutes into the attempted tire change, a uniformed man, Lt. Kyle Haltigan, Badge # P154 stopped to see if we needed help.

Did we ever! We were in a quandary as to what to do. He said, "Well lets get to it!" He started working immediately to get the tire changed. He jacked the car up, he climbed under the car to figure out how to get the spare tire down and disconnected from a very complex theft proof system. We even had to refer to the manual a few times.

It was not an easy job to get the spare tire from underneath the car compounded by the approximately 107°. We had to use second jack in order to jack the car up high enough to put the spare tire in place. He took charge and succeeded safely getting the tires changed in that heat.

We are very fortunate and appreciative to Lt. Kyle Haltigan for his help, understanding, professionalism and wonderful attitude. He is a credit to not only himself, but also to the Pinal County Sheriff's office, to Pinal County, to the general public he serves, and of course to us.

To us, Lt. Kyle Haltigan is the definition of a Good Samaritan. He was a God send!




