WHEREAS, the proposed Red Rock Project, a rail classification yard to be developed on a 950-acre site southeast of Picacho Peak will create 350 direct jobs and an estimated 6,000+ indirect jobs; and

WHEREAS, the Red Rock Project can potentially create one of the largest logistics centers in the western United States, with Union Pacific alone creating thousands of indirect jobs in manufacturing industries for area residents; and

WHEREAS, the Red Rock Project will create tremendous opportunities for supply chain and ancillary operations; and


