Levy Limit Override

Shall the Governing Board of Avra Valley Fire District of Pima and Pinal Counties, Arizona, adopt a temporary levy limit override for five consecutive tax years that allows annual levies that are exempt from the statutory tax rate limit of three dollars twenty-five cents (\$3.25), but that are subject to a tax rate limit of not more than three dollars fifty cents (\$3.50) per one hundred dollars of assessed valuation?

The purpose for requesting additional secondary property tax revenue is to generate approximately \$120,000 annually for 5 years in order to maintain firefighter jobs which have been compromised by recent decreases in tax revenue resulting from decreased property values within the District. If the voters approve the levy then (a) \$1,657,757 may be collected in the first year compared to \$1,539,345; and (b) the estimated secondary property tax rate will be \$3.50, compared to the secondary property tax rate of \$3.25 levied in the current year.
