



## **Public and Semi-Public Pool Signage Guidelines**

### **Design Requirements for Signage**

Specified in Arizona Administrative Code (A.A.C), Title 18, Chapter 5, Article 2.

- Bathing Load as calculated from A.A.C. R18-5-208.
- 'NO DIVING' in letters that are 4 inches or larger or display the international symbol for no diving. Unless the pool has specifically been designed and approved for diving purposes.
- If gaseous chlorine is used for disinfection, a warning sign outside of the door to the chlorine room which cautions persons of the danger of chlorine gas within the enclosure. The warning shall be in letters 3 inches high or larger.

### **Operational Requirements for Signage**

Specified in Pinal County Environmental Health Code, Chapter III (A.A.C. Title 9, Chapter 8, Article 8).

A sign posted within 50 feet of the swimming pool or spa that includes the following instructions:

1. Use the toilet before entering the pool or spa;
2. Take a shower before entering the pool or spa;
3. Do not enter the pool with a cold, skin or other body infection, open wound, diarrhea, or any other contagious condition;
4. If incontinent, wear tight fitting rubber or plastic pants or a swim diaper; and
5. Observe all safety regulations.
