Thank you for taking the time to come to Apache Junction and discuss the county's CDBG program. We also thank you for your interest in identifying potential projects that affect the city for inclusion in the county's Consolidated Plan.

Philosophical Statement:

The City of Apache Junction seeks highest prioritization of project considered to provide a safe community, improve the quality of life for our residents, invest in our community, and build strong infrastructure.

Based upon the city council's directive, the following projects are being proposed for inclusion in the Consolidated Plan:

1. Infrastructure improvements within the Houston Industrial Park;
2. Rehabilitation of residential structures and infrastructure improvements (including drainage) located within county islands specifically the neighborhood located off US Highway 60 and Tomahawk;
3. Rehabilitation of public housing located within the city and the county islands;
4. Drainage studies and installation of infrastructure throughout the community;
5. Roadwork on the East side of Meridian from the US60 south to Baseline addressing the city's Active Transportation Plan identified improvements;
6. Roadwork on Baseline from Royal Palm to Cactus where the road is still a rural section instead of an urban cross section addressing the city's Active Transportation Plan identified improvements;
7. Road widening along Southern Avenue between Delaware and Meridian Road.

Once again thank you for your time. The city looks forward to an open dialogue regarding the county's CDBG program in the coming funding years.

This is a follow up to our meeting on Friday, May 3, 2019 regarding the County's CDBG program. We appreciate the opportunity to include projects important to Eloy in the County's Consolidated Plan. Please include the following projects in the Consolidated Plan:

1. Intersection improvements at Sunland Gin Rd and Arica Rd, including road widening and traffic signalization.
2. Renovation and improvements to Main Street Park.
3. Road and drainage improvements on Battaglia Road from Sunshine to Highway 87.
4. Pedestrian safety improvements at the intersection of Main Street and Frontier.
5. Road improvements on W. 4th Street, W. 6th Street, W. 8th Street, W. 9th Street, W. 10th Street, A Street and Washington Street.
6. Improvements to basketball courts at Jones Park (remove /replace existing court surface, new goals, fencing and lighting).
7. Drainage improvements at the Eloy Industrial Park.
8. Replacement of playground equipment and Ramada at Fire Station Park.
9. Replacement of Playground equipment at Shumway Park.
10. Install ramada, bbq and seating areas at Washington Park.
