**WHEREAS**, the Presiding Judge of the Superior Court of Arizona in and for Pinal County is the chief judicial officer of the county and has administrative authority over all courts in Pinal County, pursuant to Article VI of the Arizona Constitution and Arizona Supreme Court Administrative Order No. 2017-79;

**WHEREAS**, the Covid-19 Pandemic has restricted jury trials in the Superior Court, due to general health considerations;

**WHEREAS**, the Presiding Judge has considered the most recently available public health information and the significantly reduced availability of prospective trial jurors at this stage of the Pandemic;

**WHEREAS**, the Court will maximize its available pool of prospective jurors by summoning all prospective jurors on a uniform day each week, rather than summoning jurors over multiple days;

**NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED** that the Clerk of the Superior Court, in her capacity as Jury Commissioner, shall summon trial jurors on Tuesdays, during any week where trial jurors are required, and

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that judges of the Superior Court shall adjust their existing jury trial schedules for jury selection to start on Tuesdays. This directive is effective immediately and shall remain in effect until further order of the Presiding Judge.

**IT IS FURTHER ORDERED** that this Administrative Order shall not apply to summoning jurors for service on the Grand Jury.
