



Figure 1 NEW DISTRICTS TAKE EFFECT JANUARY 1, 2019

The Pioneer Justice Court is currently under construction and progress can be seen as you pass the facility on Hunt Highway in San Tan Valley. Path Construction is working to complete the project by the targeted completion date of April 15, 2019. The new justice court districts take effect on January 1, 2019. The Pioneer Justice Court and the Apache Junction Justice Court will both operate out of the Apache Junction Justice Court facility located at 575 N. Idaho Road, Suite 200 in Apache Junction until the Pioneer facility is ready for occupancy.

The Apache Junction Justice Court is preparing for the precinct split going into effect on January 1, 2019. Staff is working with the Administrative Office of the Courts and Pinal County to prepare for additional staff needs and coordinating both court calendars to ensure a smooth transition. Justice of the Peace - Elect, Doug Coleman and Constable - Elect, Ted Gremmel have been working closely with court personnel to transition their offices and provide continued excellent customer service.

New Constables for Pioneer and Apache Junction

Ted Gremmel is the Constable Elect for the Apache Junction Justice Court and Mal Osgood is the Constable Elect for the new Pioneer Justice Court. The constable position is an important one within the Justice Court. Each justice court district has an elected justice of the peace and an elected constable. The primary duties of constables are:

- Executing and returning writs of possession or restitution (evictions);
- Serving orders of protection or injunctions against harassment;
- Serving civil and criminal summons and subpoenas;
- Providing judicial security to the justice courts;
- Levying and returning writs of execution (seizing property to satisfy judgements);



Justice Precinct 6 with Mile Markers




