

Monsoon Storm Rainfall Summary

This year's monsoon season has been quite active. We have already received more rainfall than the last two monsoon seasons combined. Roughly two-thirds to three-quarters of this season's rainfall total fell during the recent multi-day storm that began on July 21st and ended on July 25th.

Pinal County maintains an ALERT system that records rainfall data and transmits it to our base station for processing and use. The data is useful for planning purposes and is even used by the National Weather Service to improve the accuracy of rainfall/flood forecasting and the issuance of Flood Warnings and Watches.
