ALARM PERMIT RENEWAL BILL

- Pinal County Alarm Ordinance #111302-PCAS, your alarm permit must be kept current and renewed annually for \$18.00.
- Renewed Permit: Review the information listed within your permit (mailed to previously), provide any changes on the renewal form located on the reverse side, sign/date the bottom and return.
- You may renew upcoming years at \$18 per year. Example: 2018-2019, 2019-2020, 2020-2021 = \$54. No refunds.
- Payment: Check or Money Order made payable to "Pinal County Alarm Unit", (Canadian checks or cash are NOT accepted). *Please write your Permit Number on your payment.*
Payment: Credit Card: Pay by credit card at:

Select payment type "ALARM". Enter permit number as account number.
- Should you consider making arrangements with your bank for automatic bill pay, you would use your permit number as your account number.
- Cancelled Permits: if you have moved, sold your home or removed your alarm system, please complete the form, located on the reverse side and return. Verbal notifications will not be accepted.
- Failure to renew permit by expiration date will result in a \$25.00 fee for failure to renew permit, \$10.00 late fee plus \$18.00 permit fee.
- When did you last perform routine maintenance? Check all batteries and sensors?
