NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC

In alignment with the CDC guidelines and Governor Ducey's Executive Orders regarding, "**COVID-19**" the Pinal County Board Hearing Room is open on a limited basis.

What does limited basis mean?

The Board Hearing Room will be open for a limited number of 24 public attendees. The BOS Overflow Room which is adjacent to the Board Hearing Room will also be available for up to 10 additional meeting attendees. All other attendees will be directed to sign in providing their name, cell number, and agenda item they would like to speak on, and as space becomes available staff will contact those attendee(s) waiting in their vehicle.

Please note that all persons entering the 1891 Historic Courthouse, 135 N. Pinal St. Florence, Arizona 85132, will be required to have their temperature checked before entering the building. Some of our staff members will be wearing a mask and due to the proximity for the need to provide services, we encourage citizens to wear a mask as well.

Agenda Items: Members of the public who wish to Comment on any Agenda Item(s) may appear in-person or submit comments to ClerkoftheBoard@pinal.gov and shall be no more than 250 words by close of business (5:00 p.m.) the day prior to the meeting.

Public Hearing Items: The Applicant or a Representative may appear in-person or attend telephonically. Presentations and contact number if attending telephonically shall be submitted by close of business (5:00 p.m.) the day prior to the meeting.

Finally, and perhaps most importantly, our Pinal County team will be adhering to a strict set of sanitization guidelines for both the BOS Hearing Room and BOS Overflow Room. The safety of our citizens and staff continues to be our top priority, so sanitation will be a huge focus for our Pinal County team.
