

## About the Medication Drop-Box

Medication drop-boxes are in place to encourage proper disposal of unused, unwanted or expired prescription or over-the-counter medication. These programs are a strategy for preventing illicit drug use and unintentional poisonings in the community, and are also a way to protect our water supply from pharmaceutical contamination.

The following items can be disposed of in the Medication Drop-Box:

- Prescription Medications
- Pet Medications
- Over-the-Counter Medication
- Prescription Ointments
- Prescription Patches
- Vitamins

The following items should not be disposed of in the medication drop box:

- Needles\*
- Thermometers
- Hydrogen Peroxide
- Inhalers
- Lotions
- Liquids
- Aerosol Cans

\*Healthcare Medical Waste Services in Casa Grande will accept needles; however, there is a fee.
